## 2024 KWHA State Horse Show in Review

Ninety-seven riders from throughout Kansas competed at the Kansas Western Horseman's Association (KWHA) State Horse Show in Smith Center Kansas August 31-September 1, 2024.

A KWHA Fund Raiser Barrel Race was scheduled to occur on August 30, 2024, but due to weather and arena conditions it was decided to reschedule the barrel race to a later date.

KWHA Board of Directors held a meeting Friday evening, after the meeting the first two tickets of the Cash Dash Drawings were held. Winners of the two \$200 tickets were Linda Sanders and Ricky Solida.

There were vendors set up selling drinks, handmade jewelry, wood chairs, and other items. Food Trucks arrived with a variety of options to be had throughout the day.


