<u>Awards Committee</u>

Cameryn reported that with their \$15,000 budget, they are planning on getting 2 saddles, \$800 certificates, 1 to be awarded at the State Show, and 1 at Year End.

The State Show 1 will be a drawing. Your name will be put in when you enter. Then every time you place your name will be added, 4 times for 1^{st} , 3 times for 2^{nd} , 2 times for 3^{rd} and 1 time for 4^{th} .

The Year End 1 will be awarded to the rider with the most points overall.

Events placing at State Show will be a cash award, \$6.00 for 1st, \$4.00 for 2nd, \$2.00 for 3rd, and \$1.00 for 4th. Six places will be given in the High Point.

Year End will have 5 places for High Point.

Scholarship Committee

Linda handed out how last year's applicants replied to the question of: If it were possible, what would you change about KWHA and why?

Linda reported that half of the Scholarship fund is \$1,500. So planning on giving 2 \$500 scholarships, 1 to High School aged and 1 to higher education, 2 \$250.00 will go to either high school or higher education applicant. There will be 3 different people judging the applications.
