



Who are those who receive KWHA scholarships? They are the hard-working youth who strive to be the best inside and outside of the arena. KWHA offers academic scholarships each year with amounts determined by the board of directors.

For scholarship consideration, applicants must be an immediate member of a KWHA family, must be a member of a KWHA saddle club with current year's dues paid to the association, and currently enrolled in high school or an institute of higher learning. Applicants may receive a KWHA scholarship as a high school student or one as a student in an institute of higher learning each year.

An official KWHA Scholarship Form must be completed along with an Essay, two Letters of Personal Recommendation, and completed Involvement Cards. It is to each applicant's advantage to submit a complete, typed and informative application that portrays the student's skills, involvement, and accomplishments.

Applications will be judged according to the following percentages:

- 40% - KWHA Involvement
- 25% - Essay
- 20% - Application
- 15% - Letters of Recommendation

The school of your choice must provide KWHA proof of enrollment before funds are disbursed. The proof of enrollment must come from the school directly to KWHA via USPS.

When can I apply?

You must be a current high school student or attending an institution of higher learning.

Where can I find an application form?

An official KWHA Scholarship Application is available from kwhaonline.com or the KWHA secretary.

When is the application due?

An official KWHA Scholarship Application must be completed and signed by the applicant and sent USPS Linda Sanders 4950 W Rd 160, Scott City, Kansas 67871. Postmarked by Saturday, September 17, 2021

What do I have to do to show my KWHA involvement?

KWHA Involvement Cards will be provided when applying for this scholarship. Involvement may be helping at a KWHA/local saddle club event or KWHA horse show. These cards must be filled out and signed by a KWHA board member or KWHA judge (cannot be a member of the applicant's family). The signee must comment on how each applicant helped at this activity. You may submit as many cards as you feel are needed.

Do I have to be a KWHA Member?

Yes, you must be a member of a KWHA saddle club with the current year's dues paid to the association.

Do I have to compete in a KWHA show?

No, competing at a KWHA show is not a requirement. You must be involved in KWHA activity contributing actively to a KWHA event, saddle club, or show.

Who should I ask to complete a letter of recommendation for me?

Your scholastic ability and general character are the focus of the personal recommendations. Those characteristics may be described best by a schoolteacher, professor, instructor, or counselor.

What if there is not enough room on the application for my answers?

It is to each applicant's advantage to submit a complete, typed and informative application that attests to the candidate's acquired skills. It is fine to attach addition page(s) of information if you need more space for answers.

How are recipients selected?

A three-judge panel.

When will I be notified if I received the scholarship or not?

Scholarships are awarded each year at the KWHA Awards Banquet. Recipients are notified at this time.

If I am not awarded a scholarship, can I apply the next year?

Yes! KWHA is filled with talented, inspiring youth and you are one of them!

If I am awarded a scholarship, is it renewable?

No, applicants must reapply for future scholarships through KWHA. Once they have been granted a scholarship, students must maintain a "B"/3.0 or better grade-point average each academic year to be eligible to apply for additional KWHA scholarships. Proof of GPA must be submitted with application.
