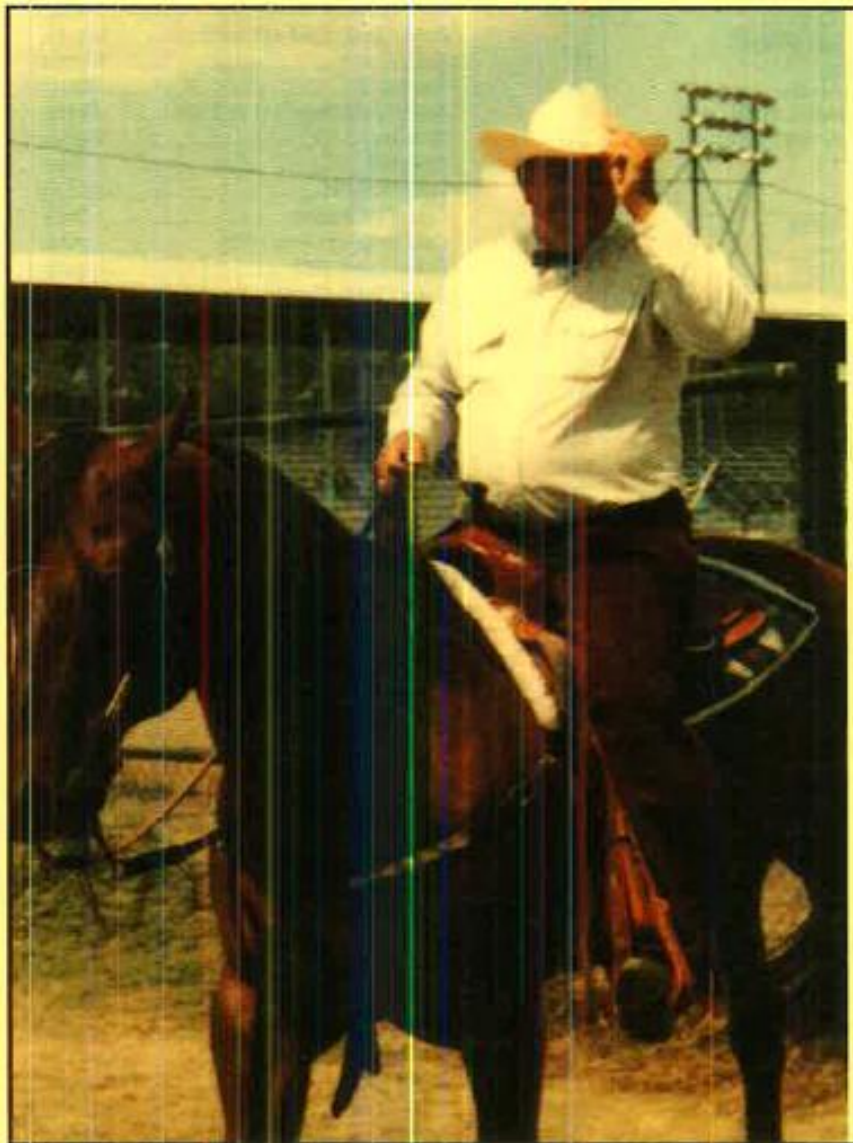

KWAH BOARD MEETING
March 3, 2013, 10:00am
HIGHLAND, GREAT BEND KS

President Shawn Kohr called the meeting to order. Those present were: Justin Bland, Troy Cooley, Kristina Sauer, Asa Galloway, Jeff Griffey, Klint Jarvis, Norleen Knoll, Shawn Kohr, Jeremy Petersen, Brandon Pratt, Rance Schreibvogel, Stan Schremmer, Penny Vargas, and Linda Sanders.

Norleen moved to accept minutes as sent, Brandon seconded the motion and it carried.

Norleen gave the Treasure's report. There was a beginning balance of \$18,682.36 and an ending balance of \$19,655.46. Brandon moved to accept and Stan seconded to accept the report as given, motion passed. Bills presented were: \$166.57 for Koozies, \$30.00 for art work redraw, and \$116.00 for banners. Rance moved to pay the bills, Kristina seconded the motion and it carried.

There is still no Horseman's Herald report; they are still working on getting everything changed to the new address. The new editor is Genea Voges.

The Equifest booth and how it went was discussed. The winner of the free membership to a KWAH saddle club was, Kathleen Huser, 2603 Emmeran, Victoria, KS 67671. Stan took the information to contact her about becoming a member of the Rocking S club. There were several clubs interested in joining KWAH.

Social media was discussed. Shawn announced if you see something that is on our Facebook page that shouldn't be discussed on there to get a hold of Linda and she will remove it. Linda is going to make 2 others administrators also.

Shawn appointed Jeff & Stan to check with their contacts about getting a KWAH web page set up.

Brandon is going to purchase the I Pad for the raffle, and then Norleen will reimburse him. He can get a 15% discount on it. When you sell your tickets send them along with the money to Norleen.

Norleen is still working on the insurance for the benefit and state show.

Bit & Spur has volunteered to have one of the benefits; Kristina contacted WaKeeney to see if they would also host one, they will not know until Monday if they can.

Brandon announced that he found out that the last 2 weekends of September are available at Kanopolis; hook-ups are \$17.00.

Clint Milliman will be our state show judge for the judged classes.

Bids for the year end meeting were discussed, and then tabled until after the committee meetings.

Getting a computer for the secretary was discussed. Brandon moved to buy a lap top for the secretary for no more than \$400.00, Stan seconded the motion and it carried. Shawn will look at the point's recorder's computer to see if he can speed it up.

Shawn said that Genea does not have Publisher, so instead of taking the lay out money for doing the Herald, he used the money to buy it for her to use.

Asa moved and Kristina seconded to accept the Butler County Cowboy Church club as a KWAH club, motion carried.

Jeff announced that he had 3 people take and pass the judge's test, Klint Jarvis, Rachelle Webb, and Chelsea Shamburg. He has made out a paper with how to give the Judge's test, and percentages of questions missed, it will be in the Judge's box.

After some discussion, Jeremy made a motion to accept the 3 passing the test upon completion of their apprenticeship, Brandon seconded the motion and it carried.

Broke for Committee meetings at 11:30, resumed at 12:30.

Committee reports

Awards-Norleen announced that the ribbons have been ordered, first place blue with 3 streamers, second place red with 2 streamers, third place white with 1 streamer, and fourth place yellow with 1 streamer, and participation green with one streamer for the kids. High point state show, first buckle, seconded breas: collar, third saddle pad, fourth halter fifth director's chair and sixth duffle bag. For year end: first buckle & jacket, second through fifth jackets. When they enter for state show they need to send their size so we know what size cf jacket to get.

Judges-Jeff is going to send the contract to Clint for state show. Will bring up rules for judge's test at the general meeting.

Finance-They decided on the caps to vote on. After some discussion, Norleen moved to order 50 of each mesh and influx, with the logo with the horse head on it and sell them for \$14.00 for the mesh hat and \$18.00 for the influx, Jeremy seconded the motion and it carried 11 to 1, Jeff opposed. Justin is going to check and see what size they sell the most of. Everyone was reminded to be getting donations for the Quartermaina.

Asa will help Brandon with the sportsmanship award.

Scholarship-Do everything you can to promote the scholarship.

Benefit- Troy moved that one benefit will be at Bentley and the other to be determined later, Brandon seconded the motion and it carried. They will be having the Diaper race, and the Western Egg class (Egg & Spoon Pleasure), a pot luck supper and a desert/live auction.

Jeremy moved start things to have the trail ride at Kanopolis on September 20-21, Asa seconded the motion and it carried. We will invite EKHA. Plan to do the Extreme horse races there. Price to be determined later.

Rules-Linda gave updated rule books to all present.

Asa wanted to know if anyone knows where the KWA banner is. Shawn will put something in the Horseman's Herald asking if anyone knows where it is.

Site for the Awards banquet were discussed. Jeff moved to have it at the Ramada in Hutchinson, Rance seconded the motion and it carried, and it carried. Rooms will be \$68.00 plus tax. Jeremy moved to have the Chuck wagon meal for \$15.95 without ribs, Penny seconded the motion and it carried.

Jeremy moved to hire the DJ we had last year spending up to \$500.00, Asa seconded the motion and it carried. Troy will contact him.

It was decided that the Benefit Shows and State Show will have the same times as last year.

Brandon moved to adjourn, Stan seconded the motion and it carried.

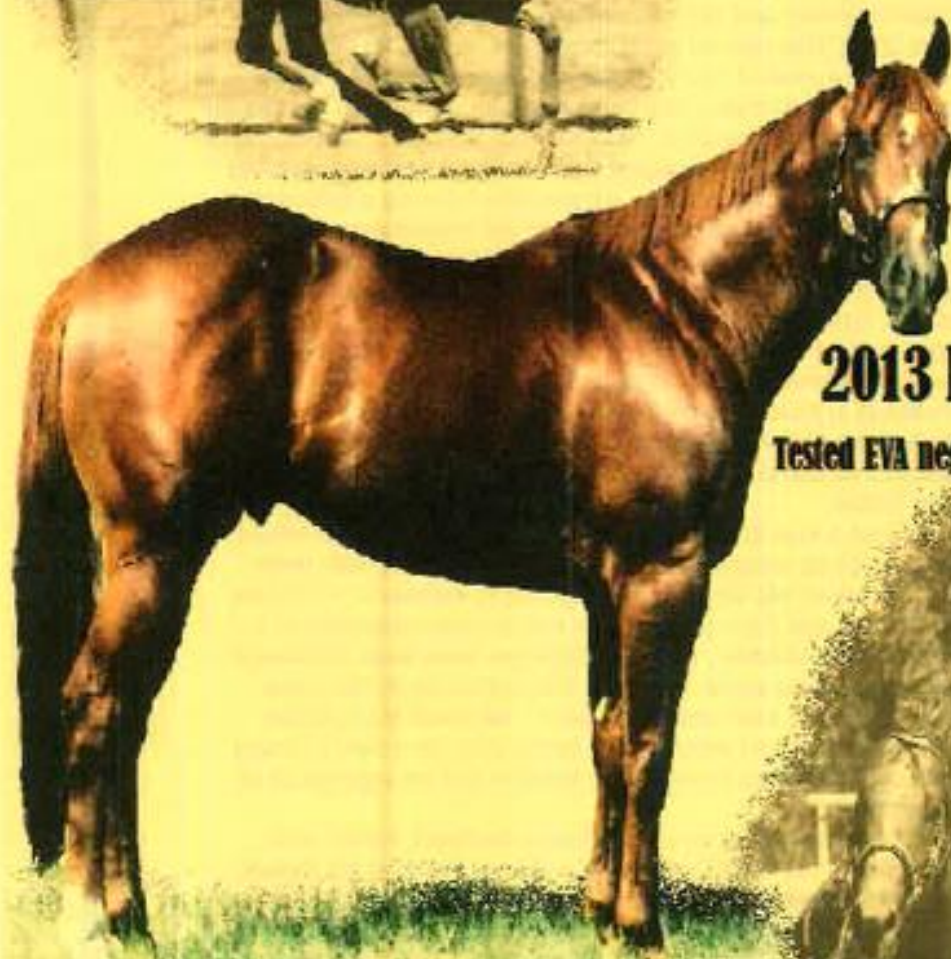

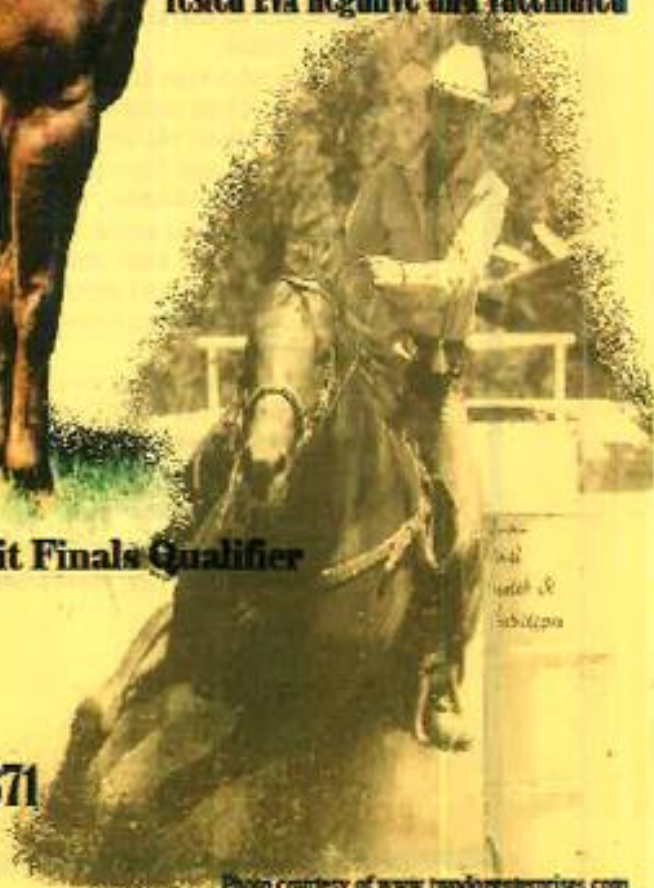
