


Reminder: All properties are measured center to center



Event Rules: One pole is centered on the turning line. A line of poles will be placed 30 feet from the start/finish line. The first pair of poles will be set 10 feet apart and on both sides of those poles 2 more poles are set 5 ft apart. Rider races between one pair of poles, crosses over and turns the end pole on the turning line and returns between the opposite pair of poles. Event can be run in either direction. Disqualifications for broken pattern or steadying poles with hand.

Measuring for Spur Race:

1. You will need to set your turn line pole and measure from the fence to the center of the pole.
2. Measure from the Start Line 30 ft towards the turn line.
3. Measure from the fence the distance of the turn line pole on that 30 ft line. This will put the turn line pole in the center of your 10ft between poles.
4. Measure 5 ft from that line to the first pole in both directions. Then measure 5 ft from those poles out for the second poles in both directions.
5. There should be 10 ft between the 2 middle poles 30 ft off the start line and it will also be 10 ft from the center to the outside set of poles.
