CONSENT AGENDA

No corrections were presented for the 2/7/26 minutes. Glenda Ratliff reported that she has been doing a 50/50 event at her Bingo to raise money for the scholarship. She asked the board if this should be made into a separate scholarship or added to the official KWHHA Scholarship account. The present BOD members weighed in and suggested adding it to the official KWHHA Scholarship Fund rather than creating a separate scholarship. Cameryn Kinderknecht moved to approve the consent agenda. Kevin Solofra seconded; motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

- None discussed

Committee Reports

- **Benefit Show - Mark Riley:** Brian Kuntz reported that he had reached out to Mark Riley regarding the buckles being awarded for the Benefit and Scholarship shows. Brian said he would follow up with him to see if they had been ordered.

- **Judges - TallyAnn Klitzke:** TallyAnn Klitzke reported that the previous judge that was agreed upon for State Show is now unable to come. TallyAnn had discussed with the committee and they suggested hiring Madison Ritcha from Kingman, KS. Kevin Solofra moved to approve the hiring of this judge, Linda Sanders seconded. The motion passed unanimously. TallyAnn also reported that Morgan Rundle, Ethan Rundle, Matthew Thomson, and Crystal Hampton have all received their apprenticeships. It was also mentioned that the Judge's Test needs to be updated and that it should be done for next year since this is a rule-change year.
- **Special Events - Camisha Stevenson:** No update provided.
- **Finance - Norleen Knoll:** In Norleen Knoll's absence, Kevin Solofra and Brian Kuntz encouraged the BOD members to sell their Cash Dash raffle tickets and to encourage members to go out and get sponsorships. Brian also reported that every buckle has been sponsored for this year.
- **Scholarship - Linda Sanders:** The committee announced they will be waiting to finalize details for the Scholarship Show until after the Benefit Show to keep things organized. Linda Sanders reported that she would meet separately with Cameryn Kinderknecht to go over the scholarship application and involvement card updates and to get them added to the website.
- **State Show - Riley Cameron:** Brian Kuntz reported that vendors have reached out to Riley Cameron about setting up booths at State Show. Discussion pursued about whether the BOD should allow vendors and possibly charge a vendor fee. There was concern about vendors with food items as it may infringe on the concession stand and baked items donated for the silent auction. Kevin Solofra moved to allow non-food vendors for a vendor fee of \$25, Glenda Ratliff seconded and the motion passed unanimously. The State Show committee will be responsible for creating a vendor form.
- **Awards - Adrienne Lobmeyer:** Brian Kuntz reported that awards for State Show have started to be ordered and awards for Year-End will be worked on later.

- **Website/Social Media - Cameryn Kinderknecht:** Cameryn Kinderknecht announced that everything is up to date on the website and she reminded the BOD to send in pictures to add to the BOD page.
- **Rules - Kevin Solofra:** Kevin Solofra reported that no rule changes have been received since Spring Kickoff in February. He said he has received less than 10 rule changes at this time.
- **Nominations - Jordan Hoesli:** There will be 8 positions up for re-election in November in addition to the President, Vice President, and Treasurer positions. It was also mentioned for the BOD to be encouraging members to run for the board.
- **Points - Kevin Solofra:** Kevin Solofra reported that he has received and been tracking points thus far into the year. He also mentioned that he is planning to write a rule change regarding late and incomplete entry/entry fee submissions from club secretaries.

New Business

- Cameryn Kinderknecht brought up that the BOD needed to determine a 3-ring committee for the Benefit Show. The BOD discussed and decided to ask Shawn Kohr, TallyAnn Klitzke, and Kevin Solofra, with the head judge being Brian Kuntz.
